What's Knee Osteoarthritis?

Knee osteoarthritis (OA) is a condition that involves the wearing down of cartilage (the protective covering on the ends of your bones) and loss of synovial fluid (which cushions your knee bones) in the joint.¹

What's an HA injection?

If you suffer from pain associated with OA of the knee your doctor may suggest Hyaluronic Acid (HA) injections. HA injections help supplement the viscous properties of the fluid in your knee joint. Our multi-regimen line of HA injections are approved for patients who have not adequately responded or have failed to find sufficient relief from analgesics, exercise, or physical therapy.²

No insurance? No problem. Our Direct Purchase Program may be right for you.

If you don't have insurance coverage for Hyaluronic Acid (HA) injections, or choose not to use it, both GenVisc®850 5 injection and TriVisc® 3 injection regimens can be purchased with a prescription directly from our exclusive pharmacy network. The Direct Purchase Program makes it less expensive for you than paying standard out of pocket prices, while your doctor retains all of the same oversight and control of administering the therapy.



A very affordable option for many patients.

Some insurance companies don't cover any or all HA injections. Others may only cover a percentage of the total cost. And for some, the high deductibles make the treatment cost prohibitive.

Some HA injections can cost up to \$1300* for a 3 injection series. With the Direct Purchase Program you typically save hundreds of dollars, making treatment both simple to access and more affordable. Furthermore, the program is FSA and HSA eligible.

Step 1: Your doctor will send a prescription for HA to a pharmacy within our network.

Step 2: The pharmacy will call you for payment by credit card. Once payment is approved the HA is shipped directly to your doctor's office.

Step 3: Your doctor's office will then contact you to schedule the necessary appointments.



Important Safety Information

GenVisc850 and TriVisc are indicated for the treatment of pain in osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee in patients who have failed to respond adequately to conservative non-pharmacologic therapy and to simple analgesics (e.g. acetaminophen).

GenVisc850 and TriVisc are contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to hyaluronate preparations. Intra-articular injections are contraindicated in cases of present infections or skin diseases in the area of the injection site to reduce the potential for developing septic arthritis.

The most commonly reported adverse events include injection site pain (6), allergic reaction (3), arthralgia (2), and bleeding at the injection site (2).

Each patient's response to HA may vary, depending on severity of your OA, degree of pain, and pre-existing medical conditions. In some patients, successful treatment may reduce pain within the first week after treatment begins, while some may respond upon the completion of the series. GenVisc850 and TriVisc are only to be administered by a licensed health-care professional.
